Subject :- Grant of Extended Permission to Sangam Sevabhavi Trust's Ayurved Mahavidyalaya, Nashik-Pune Highway, Sangamner, Dist.- Ahilyanagar-422605, Maharashtra (AYU0150) with an intake capacity of 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 15 seats in 03 PG courses in the subject namely (1) Kayachikitsa - 05 seats (2) Prasuti & stri roga-05 seats (3) Shalakya Tantra-05 seats (Opted for Shalakya Tantra Netra Roga Chikitsa-03 seats and Shalakya tanytra Karna,Nasa and Mukha Roga Chikitsa-02 seats) for the academic session 2026-27 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 -reg.

Sir/Madam,

1. To assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely **Sangam Sevabhavi Trust's Ayurved Mahavidyalaya, Nashik-Pune Highway, Sangamner, Dist.- Ahilyanagar-422605, Maharashtra (AYU0150)** inspection was conducted on **01.06.2026 and 02.06.2026 on Hybrid mode** as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM to process **the permission with intake capacity of 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 15 seats in 03 PG courses for the academic session 2026-27 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020.**
2. The visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of enforced regulations namely the Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges, 2024 provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations thereunder.
3. The assessment report was duly placed in the **172nd Board meeting** of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) convened on **18.08.2026** and Board concluded that the college is fulfilling the notified & requisite criteria for issuance of extended permission as per the Concerned Acts and regulations. Hence, the Board decided to issue extended permission with intake capacity of 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 15 seats in 03 PG courses as per the provision under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020, for the academic session 2026-27.

"DECISION"

4. Therefore, Extended permission is hereby granted to Sangam Sevabhavi Trust's Ayurved Mahavidyalaya, Nashik-Pune Highway, Sangamner, Dist.- Ahilyanagar-422605, Maharashtra (AYU0150) with intake capacity of 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course in accordance with Regulation 54 (2) of MESAR UG Ayurveda 2024 and 15 seats in 03 PG courses in the subject namely (1) Kayachikitsa -05 seats (2) Prasuti & stri roga-05 seats (3) Shalakya Tantra-05 seats (Opted for Shalakya Tantra Netra Roga Chikitsa-03 seats and Shalakya tanytra Karna,Nasa and Mukha Roga Chikitsa-02 seats) in accordance with Regulation 15 (5) of MESAR PG Ayurveda 2024 as per the provision under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020, for the academic session 2026-27 subject to condition that the aforementioned shortcomings shall be fulfilled along with the following conditions:-
 - I. Minimum **15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity with 60 seats and 15% of postgraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity with 15 seats in 03 PG courses** shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2026-27 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**
5. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
6. Further, as **per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020**, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then **in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020** the issued permission of the college

shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.

7. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
8. **Compliance of all the requirements of Aadhaar Enabled Biometric Attendance System as mentioned in the Implementation letters vide. Ref. no. 3/2024/MARB/AEBAS & HMS. Dated 09.05.2024 & 06.09.2024 issued by the Board.**
9. **The following requirements must be fulfilled and the compliance report must reach the Board by 31st December, 2026 to be considered for the issuance of permission for the academic session 2027-2028:-**
 - i) All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled,
 - ii) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024,
 - iii) All the requirements of Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Postgraduate Institutions and Minimum Standards for Postgraduate Education in Ayurveda, Regulations, 2024,
 - iv) All the requirements of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations-2022.
10. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college within the timeline as mentioned above to the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2027-28.

Note: - It is also noted that, if the concerned University does not grant affiliation to the college or withdraws the affiliation, the permission granted by MARBISM shall automatically stand withdrawn without any further notice or order.
